



CAN I REGISTER TO VOTE?

Yes – if you are:

- a Kenyan citizen;
- 18 years old and above;
- Have a National Identity Card OR a valid Kenyan Passport.

WHEN CAN I REGISTER AS A VOTER? NOW!

Registration has started!

Register soon before the lines become too long.

Registration ends on DECEMBER 18th!

REGISTER TODAY!

WHAT DO I CARRY WITH ME TO REGISTER?

You must present yourself physically at the registration center with ONE of the following identification documents;

- National Identity Card OR
- Valid Kenyan Passport

When you vote, you will be required to present that SAME national identity card OR SAME Kenyan Passport.



***Register to vote – NOW until December 18th!**

***Registration is EASY!**

***Registration is mandatory to vote in the 2013 election!**

WHERE CAN I REGISTER AS A VOTER?

At any designated voter registration center within the county’s assembly ward or the constituency where you wish to vote.

CAN I VOTE IN A DIFFERENT CENTRE FROM WHERE I AM REGISTERED?

NO. You can only cast your vote at the center where you have registered to vote.

SO REGISTER WHERE YOU LIVE AND WHERE YOU WANT TO VOTE.

DO I NEED TO REGISTER AGAIN IF I REGISTERED FOR A PREVIOUS ELECTION?

YES! EVERYONE is required to register from November 19 – December 18th to be able to vote in the 2013 election.

***REMEMBER: Registering as a member of your political party DOES NOT mean you are registered to vote in the 2013 election. YOU MUST REGISTER TO VOTE NOW!

WILL I BE ISSUED A VOTER’S CARD ONCE I REGISTER?

NO. Once you register, you will be issued a registration acknowledgement slip. You can use the registration acknowledgement slip to prove you registered.

CAN I REGISTER MORE THAN ONCE AS A VOTER?

NO! You can only register once.
