### Food Security Situation\*

- An estimated 1.6 million agro-pastoralists and marginal farming families living in Kenya's Arid Semi-Arid Lands Region remain highly food insecure as livelihoods will take at least two more favorable rainy seasons to replace livestock lost during the drought and build up marketable surpluses of grain.
- The most likely scenario: Predicted less than optimal Oct-Nov 2010 "short" rains and Apr. – Jun. 2011 "long" rains may dash hopes that food security among agro-pastoralists suffering five poor or failed seasons prior to the 2009 rains, will improve.\*
- By the end of CY 2010, refugee camps located at Dadaab in Kenya's NE and Kakuma in the NW can expect another 59,000 refugees (90% from Somalia).
